BACKGROUND

- o 1998: Aquileia has been included into UNESCO's World Heritage Sites (WHS) in 1998
- 2004: Italian government adopts the Code for Cultural Heritage and Landscape foreseeing the establishment of new legal entities for the enhancement of the public cultural heritage
- 2006: FVG Regional Law 18/2006 instituted Fondazione Aquileia for the archaeological, monumental and urban valorisation of Aquileia and for the tourist valorisation of the local territory
- 2008: (February) the Agreement between the Italian government and FVG Region (09/02/2008) brought to the identification of archaeological areas to work on, the definition of strategic valorisation objectives, the identification of an appropriate management model represented by Fondazione Aquileia itself, the approval of the activities and competences of such body and of its Statute
- o 2008: (March) establishment of Fondazione Aquileia
- 2009: the Archdiocese of Gorizia (private non-profit organisation) joins Fondazione Aquileia
- o 2016: the Ministry transfers the management of all the archaeological areas to FA



INSTRUMENTAL ACTIVITIES


- Planning and management of cultural assistance and hospitality services for the general public
