







- Most people will need, and be able, to work until they are well over 70



None can predict just what is attainable In a present that simply isn't sustainable



Eight Generic Indices for Measuring Learning Cities

1. the extent to which the city/region engages its Citizens in creating its future

to do that it will need to introduce strategies that kickstart lifelong learning for all, giving them the tools and competences to make good decisions, helping to solve problems, becoming adaptable and flexible, versatile and entrepreneurial.





Within a Learning Region every person and stakeholder Every place of education plays a lifelong learning role Functioning together to transform the region's fortunes To create a learning culture for every living soul.





Eight Generic Indices for Measuring Learning Cities

2. The extent to which the city/region engages its institutional stakeholders — businesses, higher and further education, schools, the local authority itself etc — in contributing to an environment in which economic, social and environmental development is well understood and proactively delivered.

This may involve becoming learning organisations, working in partnerships and mobilising the unique resources which each can offer.


Eight Generic Indices for Measuring Learning Cities

3. The extent to which individuals and communities contribute to the welfare of others in the city/region through active citizenship and volunteering strategies.

This may mean innovative strategies to mobilise and organise this effort












4. The extent to which the city/region embraces innovation and creativity in dealing with its economic, environmental and social issues,

including poverty reduction, social exclusion, health, disability, change and inculcating a sense of self-confidence and well-being in its people.











5. The extent to which the city/region has a strategy to maximise the potential of all its resources — intellectual, cultural, community, human, geographical, heritage, environmental, financial, health, educational, technological and economic

- in order to build a more prosperous, stable and equitable future for its citizens





- 6. The extent to which the city/region communicates its vision and its high values to its citizens, its organisations and the wider world in order to create civic esteem, shared energy and inward investment
- this will entail using all the media at its disposal

7. The frequency with which the city monitors and measures itself against a wide range of learning city indices in order to maintain the high quality of its progress.

This may entail using external specialists








8. The extent to which the city encourages a wider vision in its citizens and its organisations, and encourages them to understand and address local, national and international environmental, sustainability and humanitarian problems.

This may involve links with and between peoples and organisations from around the world to promote understanding, tolerance and shared good practice
